Dear Members of the Legal Community,

On January 29, 2019, I wrote to advise you that the Ministry of the Attorney General (the ministry) was posting a proposal to the Regulatory Registry to increase existing court fees and the fee waiver thresholds as a way to ensure court services and programs are cost-effective and sustainable. I can now advise that the ministry has received approval to proceed with its proposal as posted, subject to the change identified below.

In keeping with feedback received from the Regulatory Registry posting, and to ensure that court fees do not have an undue impact on access to justice, the ministry has also received approval to increase the fee waiver eligibility thresholds by the same percentage of the average fee increase.

As a result of the ministry's increase to the fee waiver policy, Ontario's fee waiver eligibility thresholds will be the highest in Canada. Those court users who do not meet the prescribed eligibility criteria but cannot afford to pay can continue to make a request to the court to waive the fees.

These changes will come into effect April 1, 2019.

A complete list of the fee and fee waiver increases is attached to this letter.

To assist with continued cost recovery, civil, small claims, and family court fees, as well as fee waiver thresholds, will also be automatically increased every three years by applying the Consumer Price Index, beginning January 1, 2023. Services that are already at full cost-recovery will not have fee increases applied.
