### **Changes to the LibraryCo Toolkit**

Please note that, under a new two year contract that LibraryCo has signed with LexisNexis Quicklaw, we no longer have access to the international materials such as the British and American case law that we had under the old contract. The new contract does expand the Canadian content, including quantum services, forms and precedents and Halsbury's Laws of Canada, but we are still very disappointed to have lost the international materials which we accessed on a regular basis here.

### **2010 Library Collection Update**

All libraries are facing a budget crunch in these difficult financial times and the MLA Library has not been spared. We have had to cut over \$20,000 from our looseleaf budget, representing almost a 13% reduction. We did an extensive review of our collection and selected items that had the least amount of sign-out activity. We also consulted with individual members where there were several looseleaves in an area of law and cancelled the least favourite according to their feedback. We have marked all the cancelled items so there will be no confusion and lawyers are advised to consider these items like a bound book that is current only to the date on the cancellation spine label.
